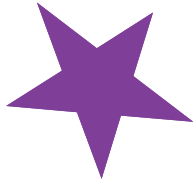

MC LEADS is a leadership-development program designed especially for Montgomery College Students.

Through this program, students will explore many facets of leadership. Participants will gain a deeper understanding of what it means to transform into a successful leader on an individual, group or community level.

This program will incorporate presentations, group discussions, guest speakers, readings, simulations, team-building exercises, service projects and assignments as we explore the Social Change Model of Leadership Development.

★ WHAT IS THE SOCIAL CHANGE MODEL OF LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT?

A model designed to enhance the development of leadership qualities in all students. Leadership is viewed as a process rather than as a position. This model promotes the values of equity, social justice, self-knowledge, personal empowerment, collaboration, citizenship and service.



★ OUTCOMES

Students will:

- Become familiar with The Office of Student Life's student leadership development programs
- Explore leadership characteristics
- Engage in team building exercises (e.g. problem solving, communication and strategic thinking)
- Expand on interpersonal and intrapersonal skills
- Enrich their college experience
