All Impact MC applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Spring 2018 student enrolled in at least 6 academic credits
- Cumulative GPA of at least a 2.0 (waived for New & Transfer Students)
- Free of academic or judicial holds
- Able to attend ALL Impact MC Meetings, Retreats, & Conferences
- Submit a complete application by 11:59PM Friday, December 8th

Up to 15 students will be selected for the Spring 2018 program.
