Overview

The Pre-College Portfolio Institute is an innovative program for rising high school juniors and seniors who are interested in applying to premier art colleges throughout the nation. For motivated students who plan to major in fine art, graphic design, or multimedia design drawing from observation and learning the elements and principles of two-dimensional design are key ingredients to a successful college educational experience.

Highlights of the Program

- A rigorous, focused study of foundation skills with an emphasis on drawing from observation
- Creating high quality artwork for the art college admissions process
- Outstanding opportunity to study in a college setting; a brand new, state-of-the-art award-winning building designed specifically for art students
- Hearing artists share their journeys from their educational backgrounds to their current success as an artist
- College-level instructors who mentor their students
- Exhibition of student work at the end of each session

Three-Week Sessions

Week 1

- Students will bring art supplies (list of supplies required will be sent with registration confirmation-around \$100 for 3 weeks) and examples of artwork completed prior to Portfolio Institute.
- Each student will have an individual review to assess areas of strength as well as areas that need improvement.
- Knowing that excellent drawing skills are the key to a high quality admissions portfolio, the first week of each session will focus on drawing from observation.
- Experienced instructors will introduce a variety of drawing methods and materials as well as elements and principles of good composition.

Weeks 2 and 3

- Gain experience working with oil paints including color mixing.
- Students begin the study of the human figure. Drawings of the live model (clothed) will be completed before painting the human figure in oils.
- Focus will be on completing high quality drawing and painting projects.
- With assistance from their instructors, students will select artwork for their portfolio.
- Expand your vocabulary of technical and aesthetic aspects of a work of art.
- There will be an exhibition of student artwork for family and friends.

6-Week Session

Weeks 1-3

- The first three weeks of this session will be the same as the three-week session outlined in the first 3-week session.

Week 4

- Drawing from observation is absolutely fundamental for fine arts students; therefore, in the fourth week continuing students will refine and augment their drawing and foundation skills. Instructor gives guidance on areas needing additional study.

Weeks 5-6

- Continuing students will draw and paint the human figure in oils and move to intermediate level independent projects after consultation with their instructor.
- Students will work with their instructor to select artwork for their portfolio.
- There will be an exhibition of student artwork for family and friends.
